**Step 2:**  
Draw a line and a circle for the legs and feet.



**Step 3:**  
Draw lines for the arms and the fingers. Use a circle for the finger tips!



**Step 4:**  
Draw the eyes and nose using circles and dots.



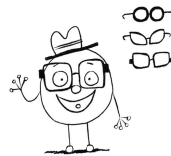
**Step 5:**

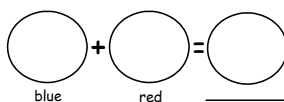
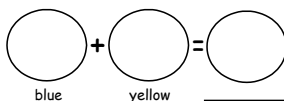
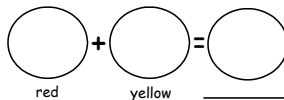


### Colour mixing
