Friday

Forest school activity

Leaf baskets

What you will need:

- A collection of leaves of different sizes, shapes and colours.
- A plastic bowl (disposable ones for parties are ideal)
- Glue
- Petroleum jelly

The activity:

- Turn the bowl upside down and cover it with a thin layer of petroleum jelly. This will help you remove the bowl later.
- Cover the bowl in a thin layer of leaves and cover thoroughly with the glue, like you would for making papier mâché.
- Keep adding layers of leaves and glue until you have several layers.
- Decorate the final layer with other objects such as seeds, catkins or anything else you can find.
- Give it a final coat of glue.
- Leave it until the leaves are dry completely, then remove the bowl.

You now have your own natural bowl to store things in. Maybe you could use it as your collection bowl for your outdoor activities. Please don't use it for food! It wouldn't be very hygienic.
