Cash Free School

We are trying to become a cash free school. You may pay for lunches, music lessons and clubs via the Pupil Asset Parent App (MIS) or direct to the school account, our details are sort code 20 62 61, account number 70412058

PA Parent App – if it is your first time using the app, tap *First Login/Forgot Password*,

Then enter the email address that the school has on record for you. When you tap *Submit*, PA will send you an email which will allow you to set your password. You need to inform school if your email address has changed
You will be asked to set a four digit PIN before you login.

Phonics

In usual times Year 1 complete a statutory screening text in Phonics in June. Those children in Year 1 in June 2020 missed the screening test.
They are now in Year 2.

The Government have asked schools to carry out a phonics screening test for these children in the Autumn Term. We will do this in November.
The children have daily phonics lessons so will be well prepared.

Play Equipment

We have new outdoor equipment. It had been planned to fit the Space Net and Monkey Bars in March so children could benefit from them in the Summer Term. This plan had to be put on hold until the summer holidays, but the equipment is there to enjoy in the future – it just needs to stop raining!

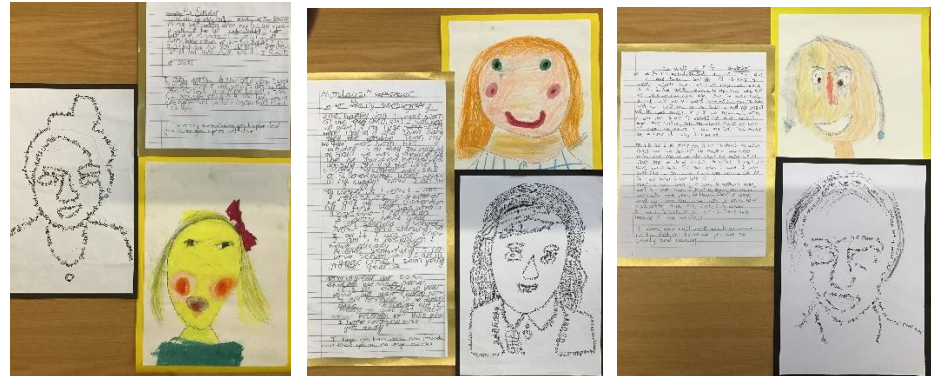
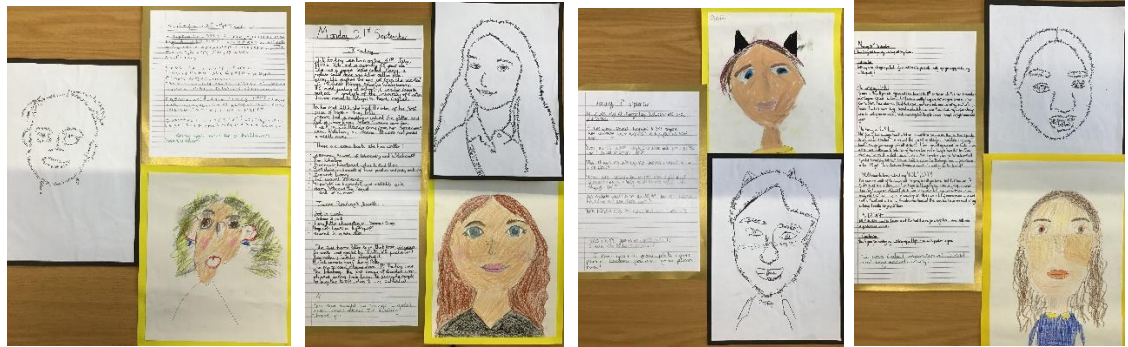
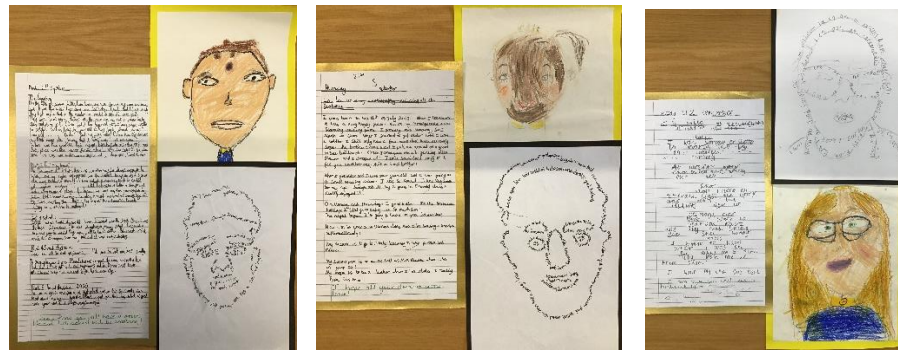
