To support Anti Bullying, we wore odd socks.

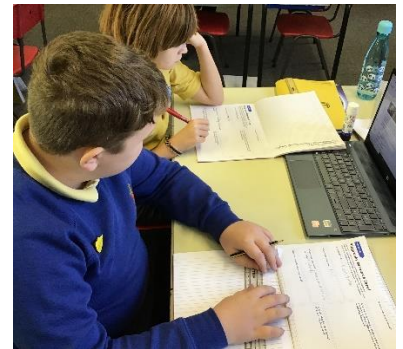
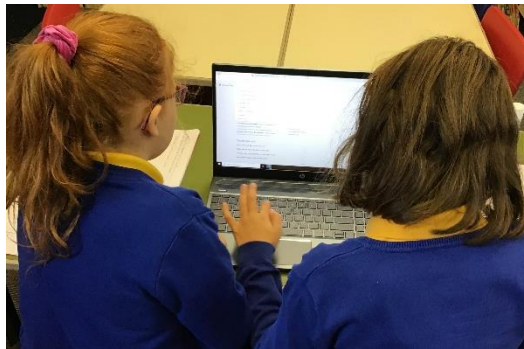
