Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you had a lovely restful Christmas break and are ready for a busy Spring Term! We will of course settle the pupils back in to routines on the first few days back and take time to ensure that they are happy and ready to learn.

In English this term, Year 3 will be studying The Hodgeheg by Dick King Smith and Year 4, 5 and 6 will be studying Crystal of Storms by Rhianna Pratchett. We will read, learn and write a range of poetry ready for our own in school Poetry Festival in March. We will also look at persuasive writing which will culminate in the pupils writing their own persuasive leaflet to persuade people to live a healthy lifestyle. Pupils will continue to be encouraged to read a range of own choice books.

In Maths, we will continue to concentrate on the four operations and the application of these. We will also study place value, properties of shape, algebra, fractions, measurements, perimeter and area. Year 5 and 6 will also study percentages, ratio and proportion. Year 3 and 4 will practise times tables daily and it would be helpful if all year groups could continue to practise at home too. Knowing all your tables to 12 times 12 really helps in a number of areas of maths.

In topic, we will be studying China and Mountains, Volcanoes and earthquakes. Please see the attached curriculum plan for further details. Science is a Biology unit this term learning about living things and habitats.

Homework will remain the same and your child should complete one work unit in Maths and English a week. Spellings will be set and tested every Friday too. Your child's homework pack needs to be in school every Friday so that we can mark it. Please also remember that there are English, Spelling, Maths and Tables Doodle accounts that can be completed daily. Your child will be rewarded with house points every time they complete a daily activity.

Should you and your family have to self-isolate at any point, home learning is placed on Google classrooms weekly. Please let school know so that we can send home maths textbooks and any other work that your child will need.
