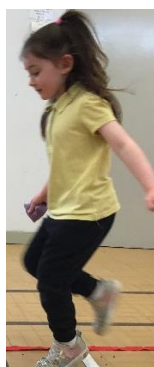
Fleggburgh CE Primary School
