Food for thought


Research in the United States has shown the impact of parents reading with their children. Here's how many words children would have heard by the time they were five years old, when:

Never read to 4,662 words

Read to 1-2 times per week 63,570 words

Read to 3-5 times per week 169,520 words

We know as teachers that reading little and often makes such a difference to children's progress in all areas of the curriculum.




Can you spare an hour?


